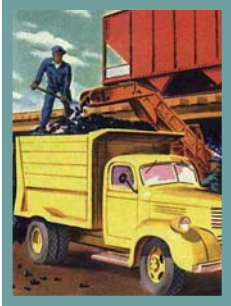
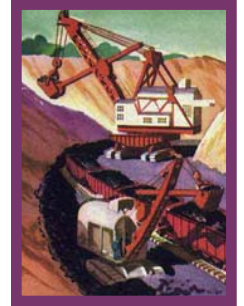


TEST YOUR KNOWLEDGE!
